Membership for the Tri-M Music Honor Society is based off of five components:

Musicianship: Members are required to be active and enthusiastic music students in at least one performing arts class each semester.

Leadership: Members must exemplify leadership skills and inspire others in both the school and community through their dedication to their music programs.

Character: Students must demonstrate respect, kindness, trustworthiness, integrity and citizenship at all times.

Scholarship: Students must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher both semesters.

Service: Students must participate in service projects within the school and community.

Requirements

- Proper documentation of 7 community service hours and 3 concert credits are due by the end of each semester.
- Participation in Music in our Schools Month in March is mandatory.
- Participation in at least one Tri-M group project throughout the year is mandatory.
- Payment of the \$15 annual membership fee is due by October 2nd.
- Attendance for every meeting is mandatory. Excessive absences will result in dismissal from the Honor Society. Meetings are before school at 7:15 and after school at 2:10.
